SUMMARY: The Kitchen Support Staff is a part-time position (20 hours per week). They will work under the supervision of the Chef to support the essential functions of the kitchen. This will include: washing dishes, cleaning surfaces, sweeping/mopping floors, taking out trash, and other essential kitchen functions. We are seeking a person with a positive, hard-working attitude who desires to support a program that provides important services to children and families.

WORK ENVIROMENT: While performing the duties of this job, the employee works in a kitchen within a preschool setting. The noise level is moderate to loud. Spaces may be somewhat confined.

The environment will require active movement. While performing the duties of this job, the employee will frequently be required to stand; walk; bend, sit; use hands to handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls; reach with hands and arms; talk and hear.
